INTRODUCTION TO CONDITIONAL GRANTS AND EARMARKED FUNDS IN NORTH WEST PROVINCE

- North West Province receives following conditional grants for agriculture development from DOA:
 - CASP provides land and agrarian reform support to the targeted beneficiaries through six pillars
 - Landcare a community-based programme (integrated approach to sustainable use and management of natural agricultural resources)
- North West Government has following earmarked funds for agriculture development:
 - Post Settlement mainly focuses on support to land reform beneficiaries (agricultural training, infrastructure development and production inputs)
 - Support for Communal Farmers focuses on providing support for resource for armers on communal land
