# POLICY ENHANCEMENTS

# The main elements of the proposed enhanced People's Housing Process are:

- To build the understanding of what the People's Housing Process can achieve if designed and supported properly;
- To create an enabling legislative and institutional environment for enhanced PHP delivery;
- To build the capacity of government at all spheres to support the delivery of PHP;
- To allocate adequate resources to ensure implementation on the ground;
- To allow for the provision of flexible solutions to demand-side needs.
