- Consolidation and relocation study completed
- Relocation to single site is costly (up to R2 Billion)
- Manufacturing processes are interdependent "all or nothing" and have downstream implications for Munitions and Denel Dynamics (motors, warheads)
- Overheads are high due to replicated management
- Operational efficiencies can be improved with updated plant and improved processes
- Munitions should be a sustainable business at minimum turnover of R1.15
 Billion p/a and with cost cutting
- Strategy therefore to continue operations at four explosive sites with consolidated management
- Implement tight controls with annual review of sustainability of Munitions business
