GDC Historical Background

- ◆ Pre 1994: legislation & gov. policies
- ◆ Post 1994: Apartheid Legacy
- ◆ 2004: 10 Yr Gov. & GDC Review

Key Findings

- Progress in transforming State for proactive action and responsiveness to GDC issues
- Collaboration between Gov & civil society
- Inadequate baseline & statistical data and agreed indicators to measure progress
- Poverty and unemployment still hamper delivery on GDC Constitutional mandate

Functions of the National GDC Structures



- ◆ Mainstreaming of a GDC centred approach in institutional processes in SA
- ◆ Service delivery or External Transformation
- ◆ National, Regional & International Reporting

Expenditure Framework: GDC - Presidency

- ◆ Mainstreaming of GDC issues in governance processes – including policy analysis
- ◆ Monitoring, evaluation, advocacy for CR delivery in Gov., and coordination of integrated policy implementation
- ◆ Capacity building towards internal transformation
