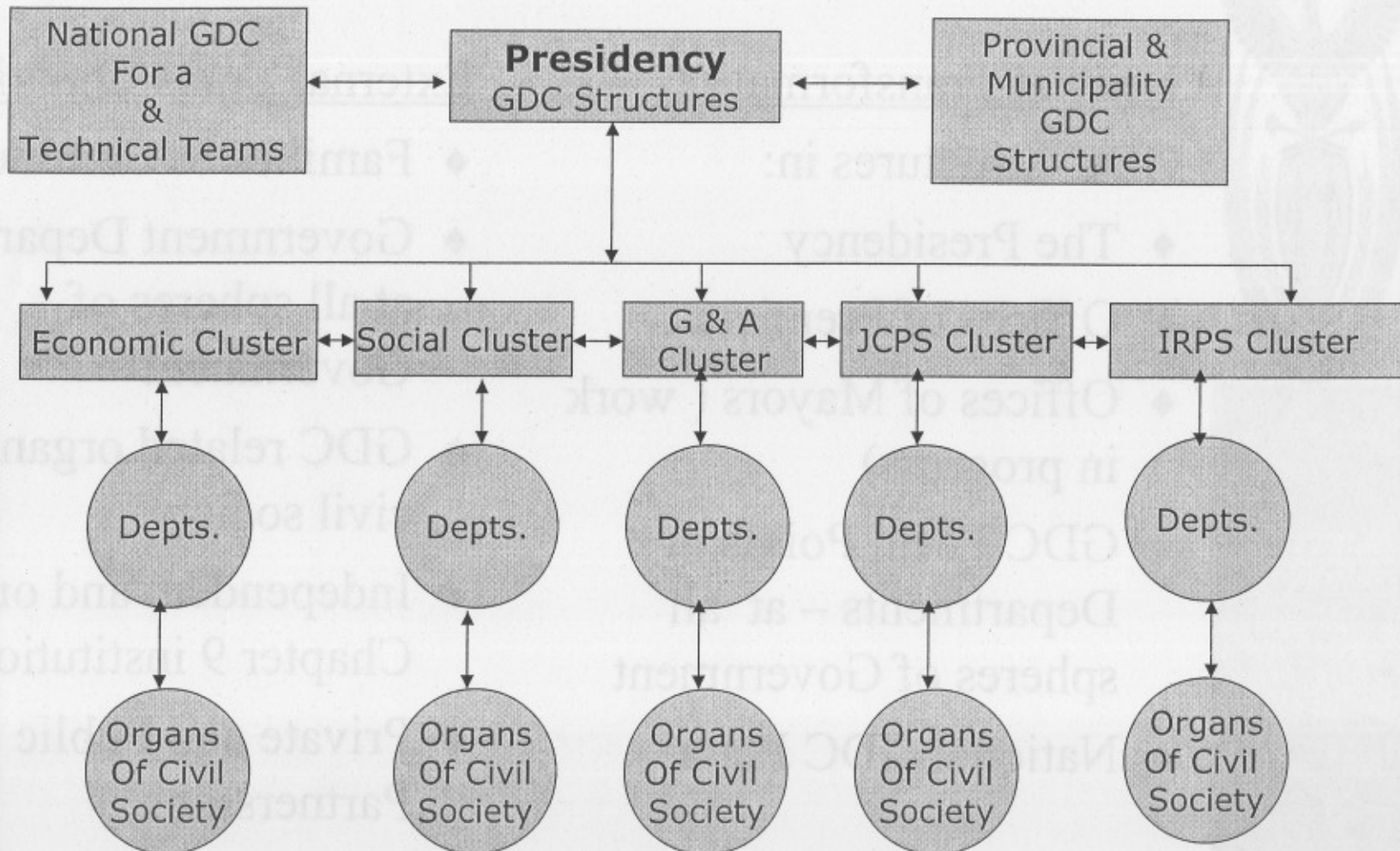


# GDC Programme Coordination Framework

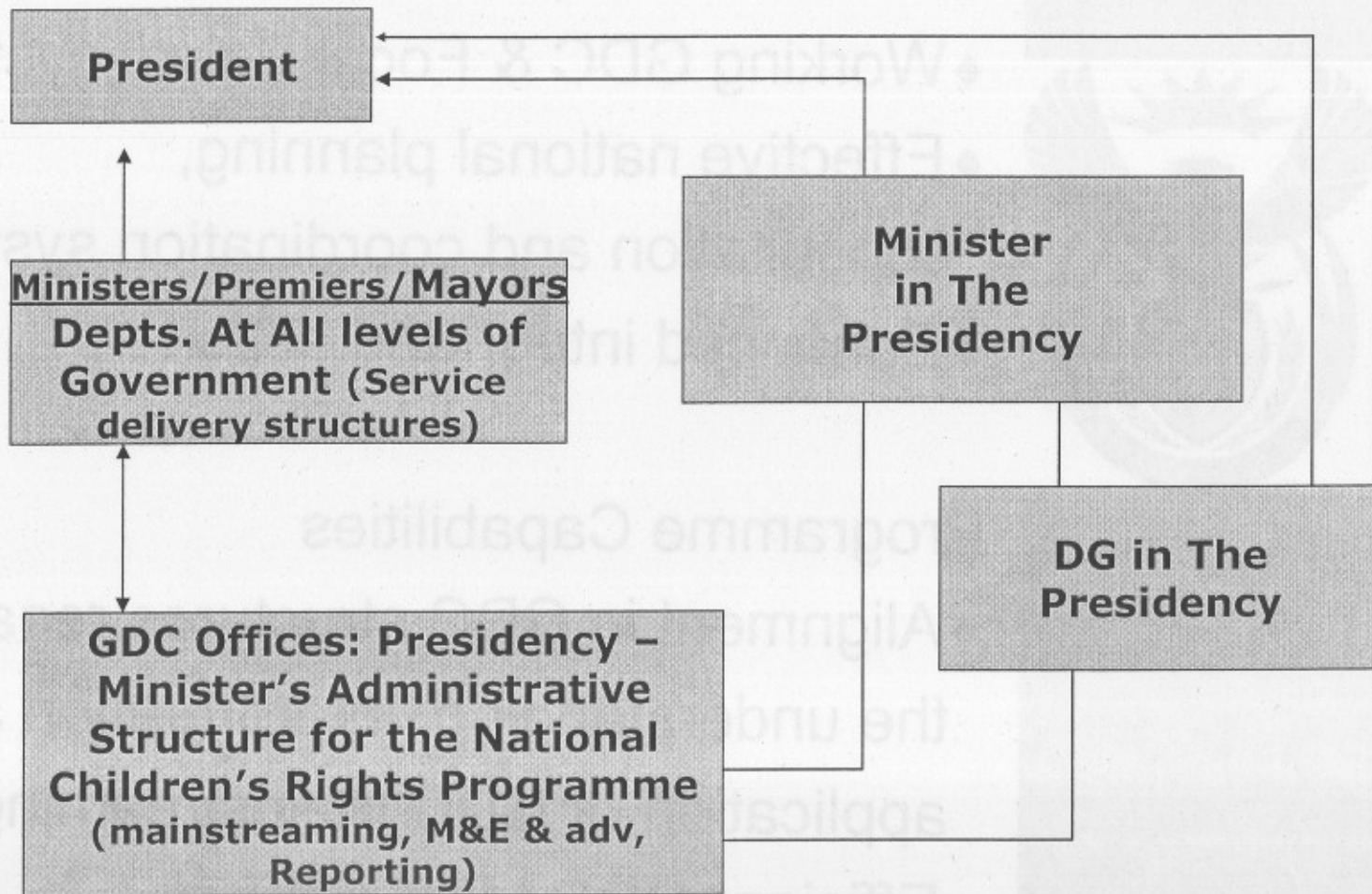

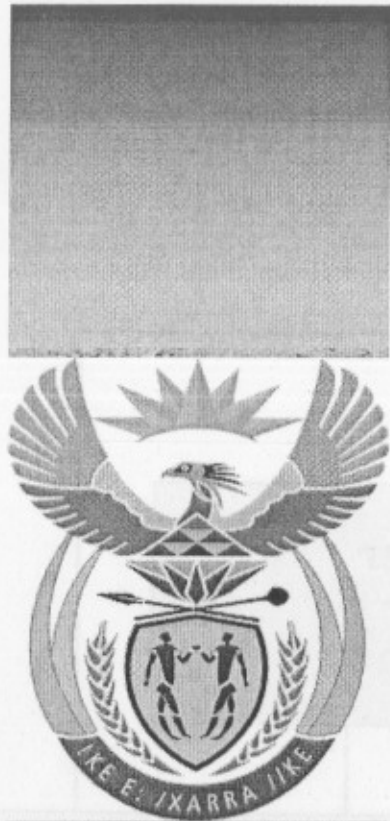
# GDC Performance Indicators: 2009

## Key GDC Challenges and Delivery Constraints

- ◆ Inadequate awareness of existing GDC quality life policies and resources in SA
- ◆ Differential understanding of the concept “mainstreaming” in Gov
- ◆ Inadequate human capital and competencies in Gov for GDC mainstreaming, policy analysis, M&E and coordination of integrated policy implementation

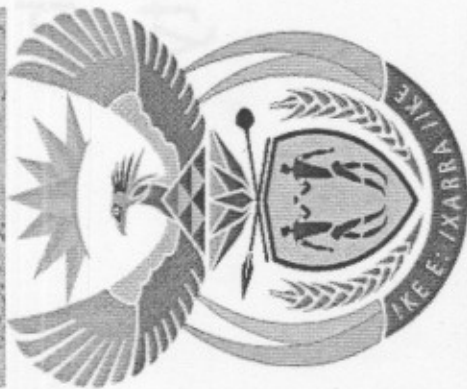


# Challenges
