RE-CAP PUBLIC HEARING

I wish to make this clear that the members of the industry are very much positive about the recap.

Yes, the majority of us is longing for the recap but members have some concerns.

1. Scrapping of vehicles

- The government has implemented the system of scrapping. The members need clarity around that.
- If one takes ones vehicle for scrapping which vehicle has been recommended by the government? Or which vehicle does he recommend that we should buy, when he says we should scrap our vehicles? At the look of things he has nothing in place.
- If I hand over my vehicle for scrapping, how long will I wait for the next one. Time frame is important.

2. Inclusion of our members

- We need total inclusion of our representation in the process.
- The result of the failure in the Gazelle would have long been picked up if our members voice was heard.
- Our members are more experienced about these vehicles compared to the committee that sits and decides for the industry.
- Members need to know exactly the contents of the recap.

4. **Reconsideration of government's offer**

- Is R50, 000 suitable for both operating licence and the vehicle?
- Those are questions need to be debated.
