- Increase shown in the form of fieldwork-based research as recommended by AISA's Institutional Review in 2004.
- Researchers produced policy-related papers and presented the results of Africa Institute of their research at conferences, seminars and briefings

- Minimum of two fieldwork assignments per researcher
- Funding dependent on rigorous assessment of the academic merit and alignment to AISA's mandate
- Eight researchers were awarded funding for fieldwork research in Nigeria, Cameroon, Mozambique, Kenya, DRC, among other countries
