An extract from Deed of Grant 4671 of 1875 in respect of the property Upper Umkomas. This gives the description of the property as "comprising one thousand six hundred acres English measurement or thereabouts, the same more or less bounded south by the river Gwangwane, to the east by the Umzimkhulu river and northwest by Crown Land.

The extract illustrates the vagueness of the registered title deed information compared with the information recorded in the Boards assets register as a result of re-inspection and re-survey.
