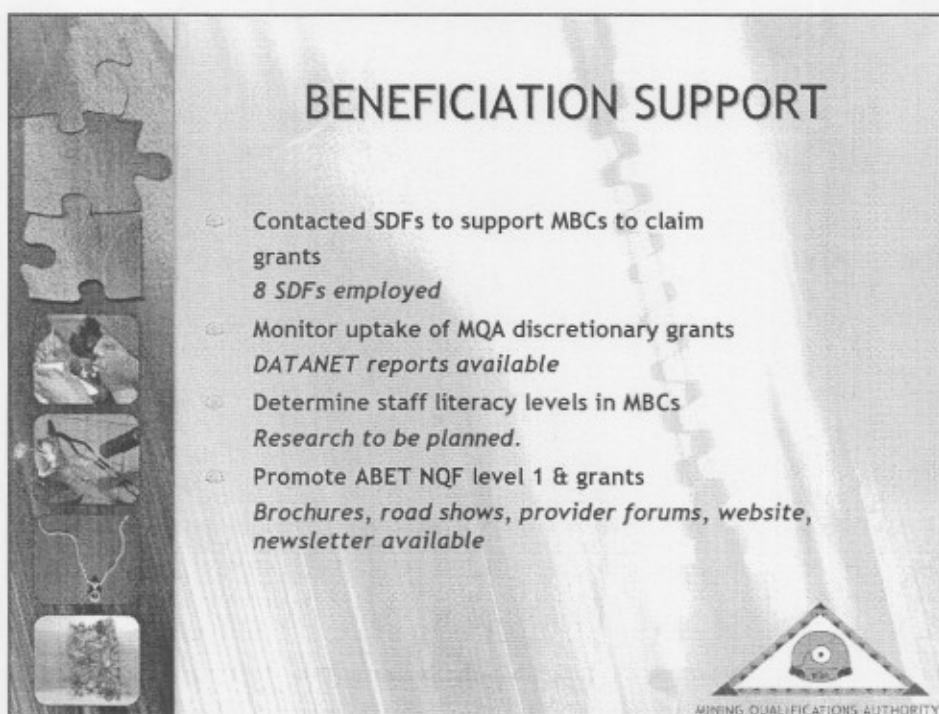
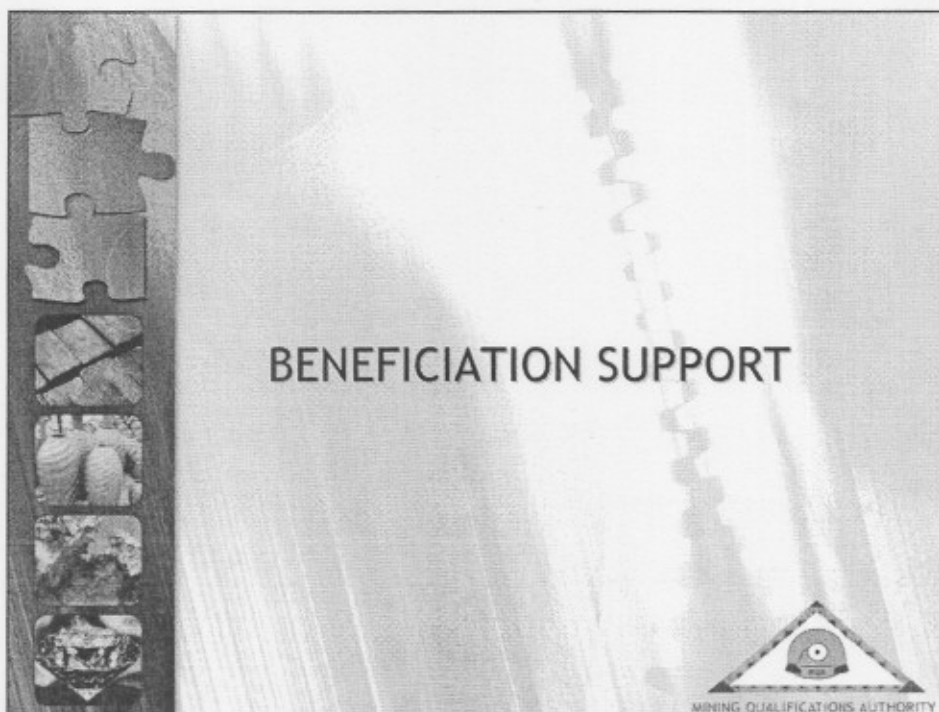
- **New enterprises skills development (New Venture Creation)**
