May I respectfully submit that I, together with the vast majority of South African citizens, are opposed to and in fact disgusted that our beautiful South Africa would even be considering such an ungodly law as the Civil Union Bill.

Homosexuals are to be pitied and helped, not to be encouraged to continue in a lifestyle which God clearly detests. (Lev.18:22; Lev.20:13; 1Cor.6:9; Rom.1:24-31) God judged Sodom and Gomorrah for this sin and destroyed them completely.
