

PURPOSE OF PROGRAMME

 To protect and improve the quality and safety of the environment

AIM

 Environmental Quality and Protection (EQP) aims to protect the constitutional right of all South Africans to an environment that is not harmful to health and well-being, through legislative and other measures.



PROGRAMMES

- · The programme has the following seven sub-programmes:
 - Management
 - Environmental Impact Management ensures that the possible negative impacts of new developments are minimised, mitigated or managed
 - Air Quality Management and Climate Change ensures that reasonable legislative and other measures are developed, implemented and maintained in such a way as to protect and defend the right of all to air and atmospheric quality that is not harmful to health and well-being
 - Regulatory Services ensures that: environmental quality and protection-related authorisations are legally defensible and enforceable; compliance with all environmental quality and protection related legislation, and regulations is efficiently and effectively monitored; and effective enforcement measures are taken for cases of serious, significant or continuous noncompliance with environmental quality and protection-related legislation

PROGRAMMES

- Pollution and Waste Management seeks to reduce the impact of chemicals and hazardous waste on safety, health and the environment; promote the efficient use of energy and raw materials; reduce the impact of non-hazardous waste on safety, health and the environment; and encourage cleaner production, waste minimization and recycling through various policy instruments, including the use of economic instruments.
- Financial Contributions are made to the South African Weather Services yearly.
- Financial Assistance is provided to the section 21 company Buyisa-e-Bag as part of the implementation of the plastic bag regulations.
