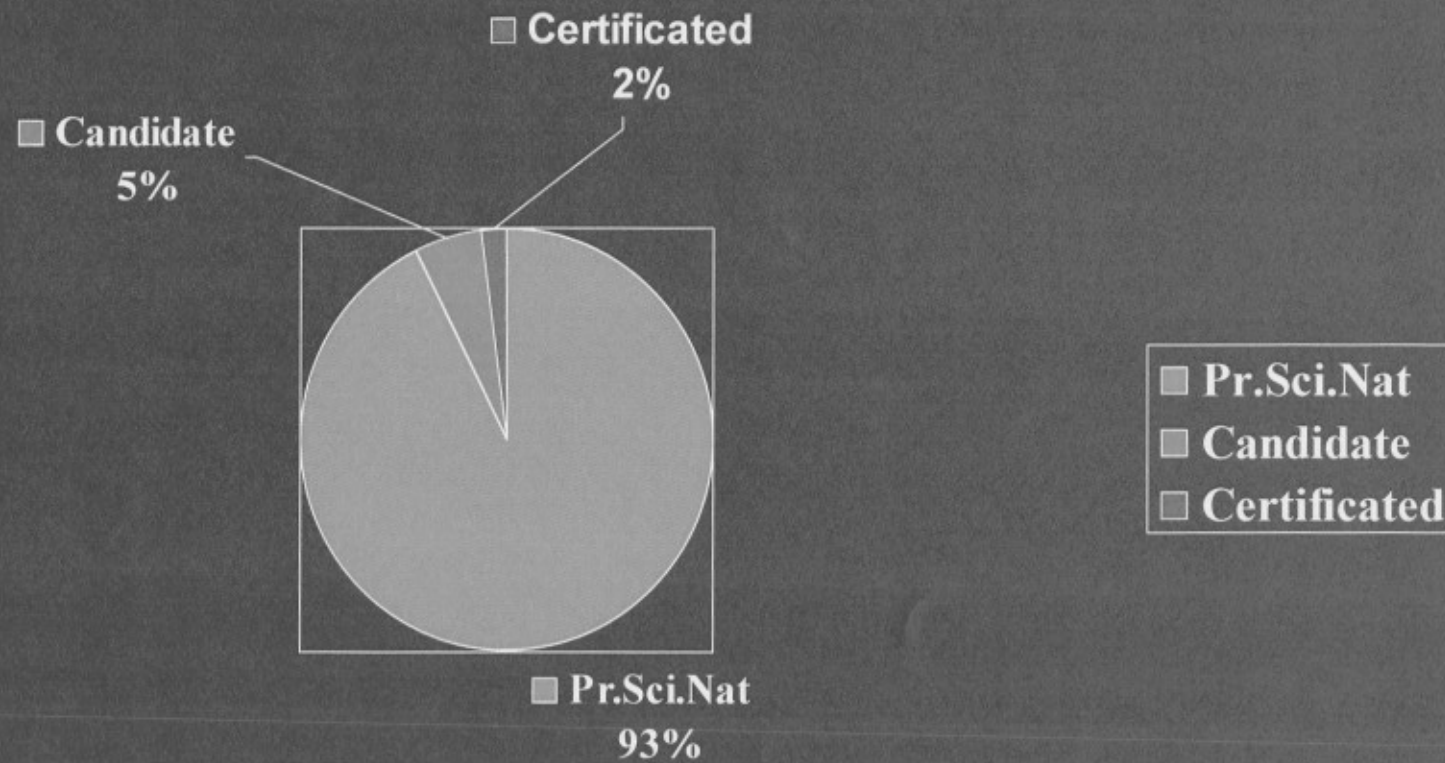
REGISTRATION STATS

- Still relatively few registered black and female scientists but the steady increase for both categories continued

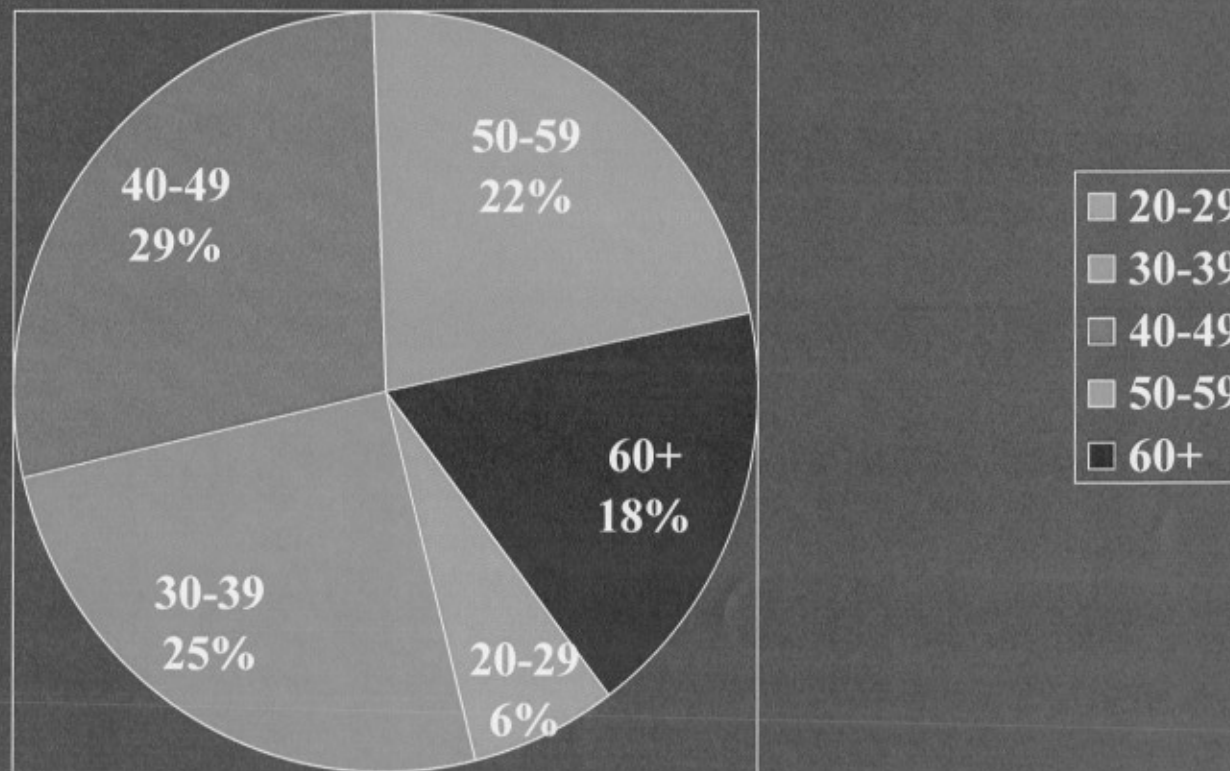

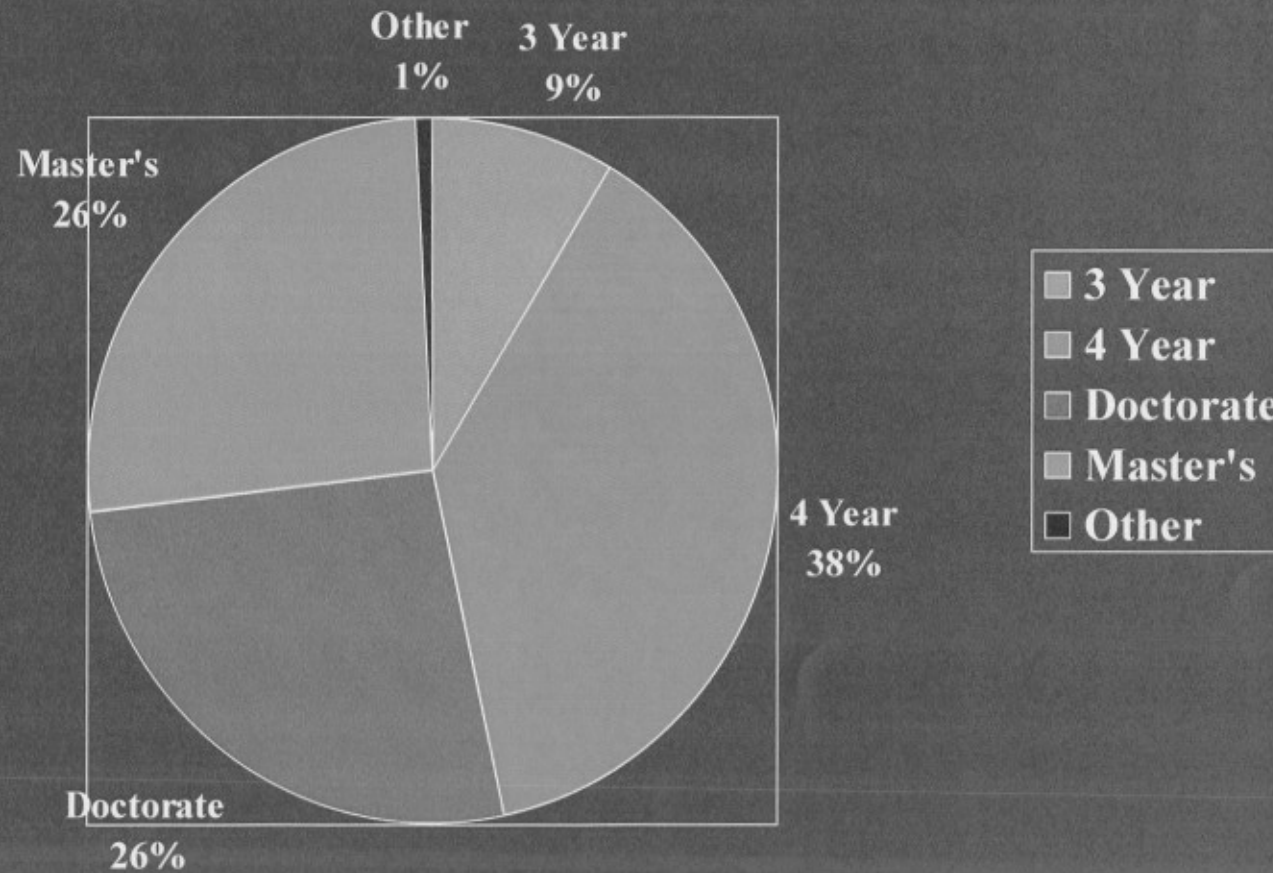
REGISTRATION ACCORDING TO CATEGORY



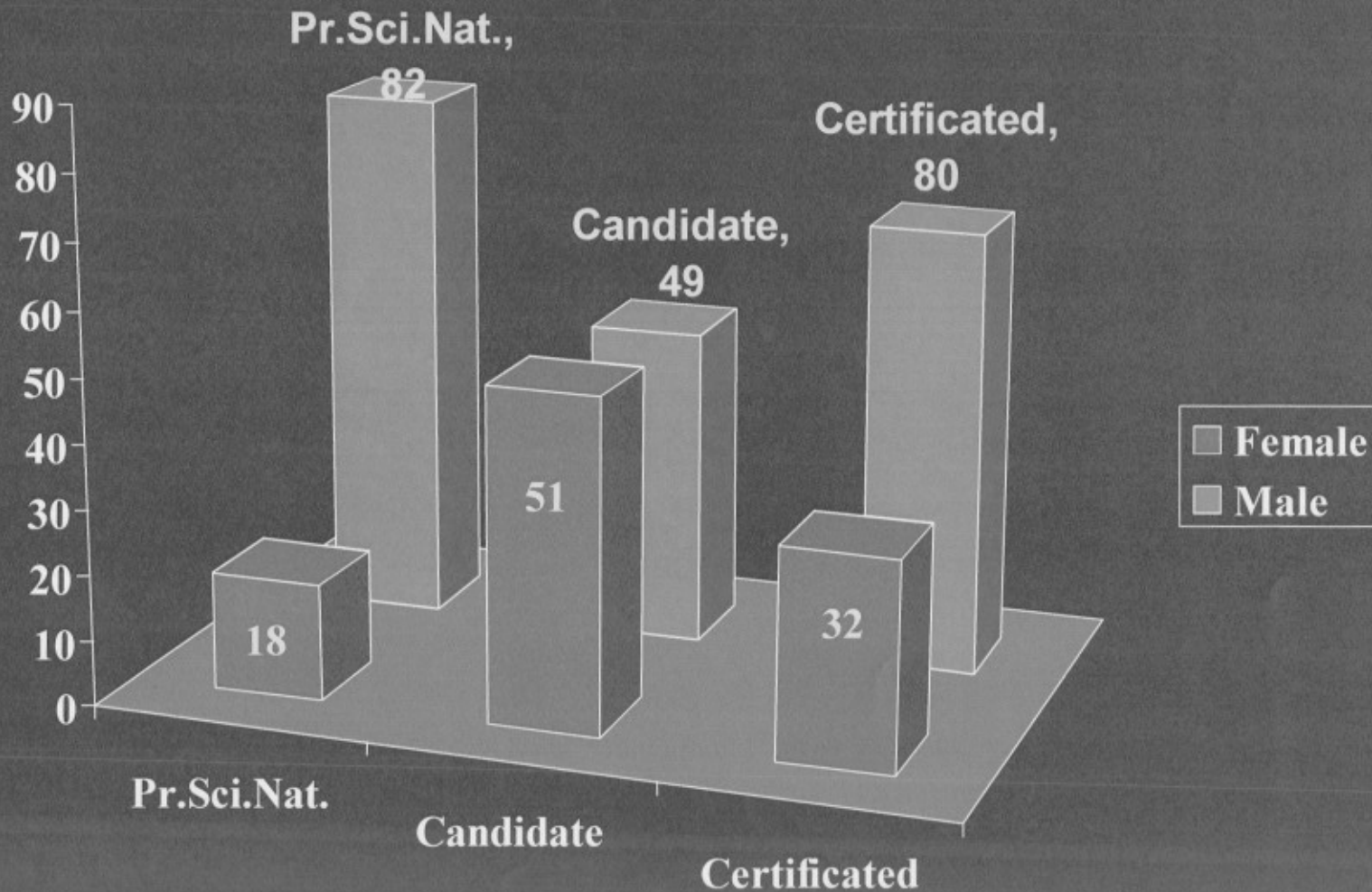
AGE DISTRIBUTION



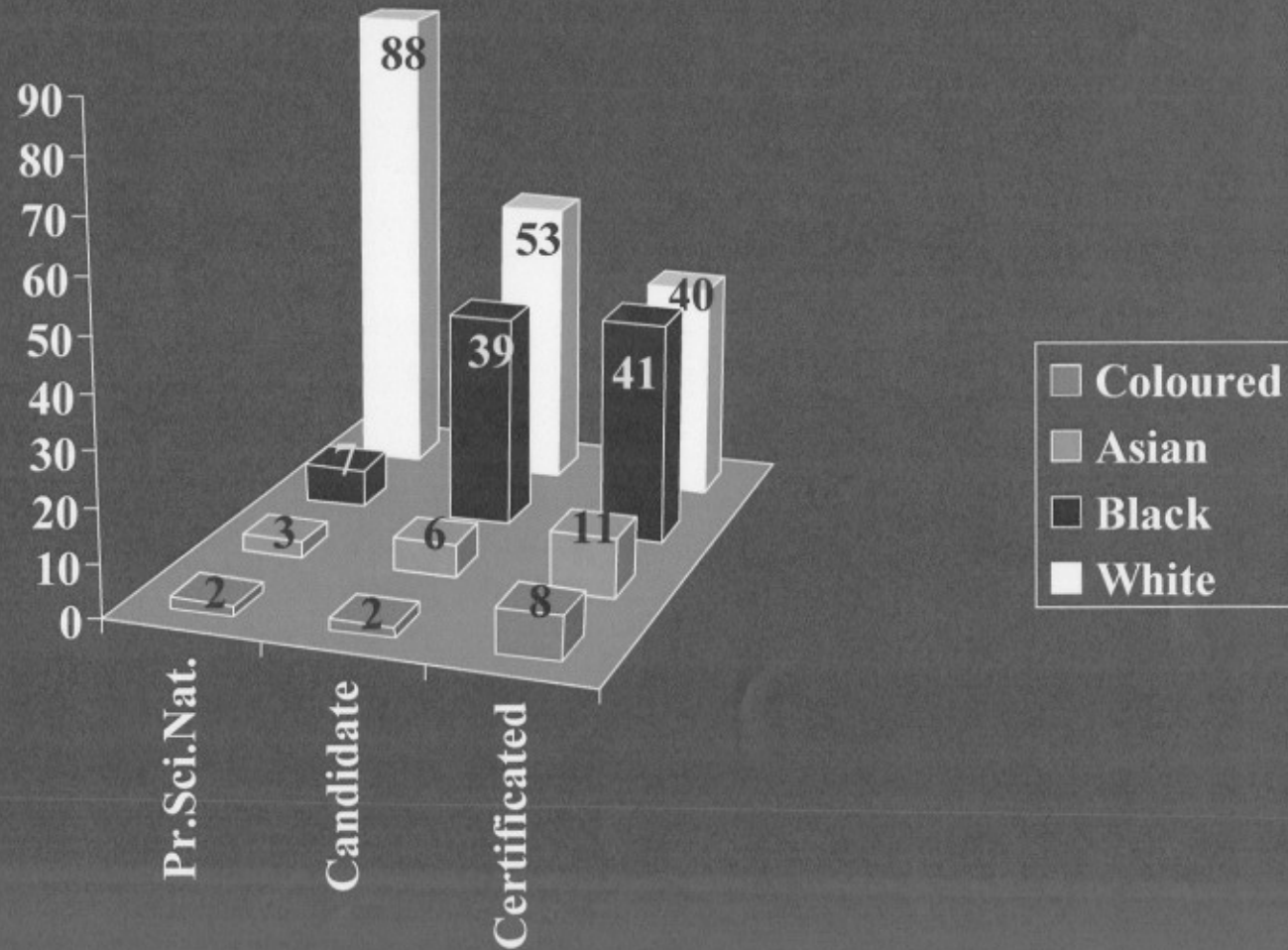
QUALIFICATIONS
