1. Terms of reference

The Children's Amendment Bill [B19D-2006], herein referred to as the Bill, was referred to the Portfolio Committee on Social Development by the NCOP Business Committee for consideration.

2. Consideration of the Bill (B19D-2006)

The Portfolio Committee was briefed on the content and effect of the Bill as amended by the National Assembly by the Chairperson of the Committee, Hon. Z Tom and the Legal Advisor of the Legislature, Mr. L I Netshitumbu. The Committee welcomed the amendments as they strengthen the Bill.

The Committee has also resolved to inform stakeholders of the amendments and a workshop will be done for this purpose.

3. Resolution

The Committee resolved that the following final mandate be conferred:

- (a) To vote against the adoption of the Bill (B19D-2006).
- (b) The Permanent Delegate for the Province of the Eastern Cape represents the Province of the Eastern Cape at the meeting of the final mandates in voting against the adoption of the Bill.

VOTE OF THE KWAZULU-NATAL PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE:

The Provincial Standing Committee on National Council of Provinces Matters met today, Monday, the 19th of November 2007 to confer a final voting mandate on the Children's Amendment Bill [B19D-2006].

The NCOP Committee resolved -

- To reject the Bill for purposes of conferral of a final voting mandate on the provincial delegation, to enable the Bill to be referred to mediation in terms of section 76(2)(d) of the Constitution for correction of the textual errors referred to under Item 10 of the Minutes of Proceedings of the National Assembly dated Tuesday, the 6th of November 2007;
- To mandate the provincial delegate designated to attend the Mediation Committee to support the Bill, as amended by the National Assembly [B19D -2006], subject to the textual corrections referred to in paragraph [1] above being effected;
- To draw attention to a further textual error on page 8 of the Bill [B19D -2006], in line 38: the words [partial care] appear to be incorrectly omitted; and
- To mandate the provincial delegation to support the Bill, as amended in accordance with paragraph [2] above, when the Bill is referred to the National Council of Provinces in terms of section 76(2)(g) of the Constitution.



FINAL MANDATE ON THE CHILDREN'S BILL [B19D-2006]

The Children's Bill was referred to the Legislature and the Bill was subsequently referred to the Portfolio Committee on Health and Social Development for consideration. The Committee having considered the Bill reported to this House for conferral of a Final Mandate. The final mandate was accordingly conferred to the NCOP Delegates to vote in favour of the Bill.

The NCOP made amendments on the Bill which were to be approved by the National Assembly but the National Assembly made further amendments which needed the approval of the NCOP. This resulted in the Houses of parliament having a stalemate in the processing of this piece of legislation.

The NCOP having realized that there are serious technical problems with the Bill decided that the Bill be rejected to allow for the mediation process as provided for in the Joint Rules of Parliament.

It is in this context that the NCOP has requested Provinces to confer fresh mandates on the Bill and that Provinces should reject the Bill.

The Portfolio Committee on Health and Social Development having considered the provisions of the Bill and the amendments made on the Bill by the National Assembly recommends to this august House to confer a mandate to the NCOP Delegates to reject the Bill as amended by the National Assembly.

FINAL MANDATE: CHILDREN'S AMENDMENT BILL [B19C-2006 & B19D-2006]

(Section 76 Bill)

1. INTRODUCTION

The Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Social Services & Population Development, Hon SE Lucas, accompanied by the Legal Advisor attended a briefing session in Cape Town on 13 November 2007 to discuss the Children's Amendment Bill [B19C-2006 & B19D-2006].

2. PROCESS FOLLOWED

The Speaker of the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature has on receipt of the Bill referred the Children's Amendment Bill [[B19C-2006 & B19D-2006] to the Portfolio Committee on Social Services & Population Development on 07 November 2007.

The Portfolio Committee received a briefing on the Bill at its meeting on 15 November 2007.

On 15 November 2007, the Portfolio Committee on Social Services & Population Development deliberated and considered the Children's Amendment Bill [B19C-2006 & B19D-2006] and agreed to reject the Bill due to technical and grammatical errors.

3. COMMITTEE RESOLUTION ON THE BILL

The Committee rejected this Bill duly signed by the Chairperson of the Committee.

In terms of Section 65 of the Constitution, Act 108 of 1996, the Portfolio Committee on Social Services & Population Development recommends that the House confer authority on the Head of its Delegation to the NCOP to reject the Bill in its current form.
