# Intention



- To give effect to agreement between DEA and Weather Services on establishment and management of air quality information system.
- No changes to relationship between regulator and industry.



#### **Current situation**



- Licensing regime still not operational
- Inconsistent messages on licensing requirements
- Advice on requirements provided by national and local government
- Information to be provided in license application still not clarified
- Concerns around public access to confidential business information not resolved





- Development of phase 2 of SAAQUIS includes stakeholder involvement
- GHG inventory subject of co-operation between BUSA and DEA



# Scope of responsibility



#### Advisory services:

- inclusion of air pollution concentrations and emissions beyond scope of weather services mandate
- pollution warnings : responsibility of industry not recognised
- duplicating responsibility of competent authorities



#### Scope of responsibility(2)



- Instruments:
  - should be confined to information management
- Research:
  - should be confined to Weather Services
- Training in air quality not appropriate function for Weather Services



# Pollution warnings



- Purpose of pollution warnings not understood
- Emission incidents must be reported in terms of NEMA
- Warnings to the public required in terms of Major Hazard Installation regulations
  - Emergency response measure; cannot wait for written permission



#### **Amendments**



- Delete definitions not used in the Bill
- Delete restrictions on pollution warnings
- Delete advisory and consultancy services on individual emissions
- Include restriction on use of business confidential information collected as part of license application
- Delete limitation of liability



## Amendments (2)



- Ambient air quality is available from a variety of sources: definition should clarify those that will be used
- No limit on the sources of information to be used for consultancy services
- Relationship between this service and advice given by competent authorities should be clarified



## Amendments (3)



- Limit on the sources of information to be used for consultancy services
- Clarify costs of this service
- Clarify relationship between this service and advice given by competent authorities
- Include IPR protection for information submitted by industry in section 26.
